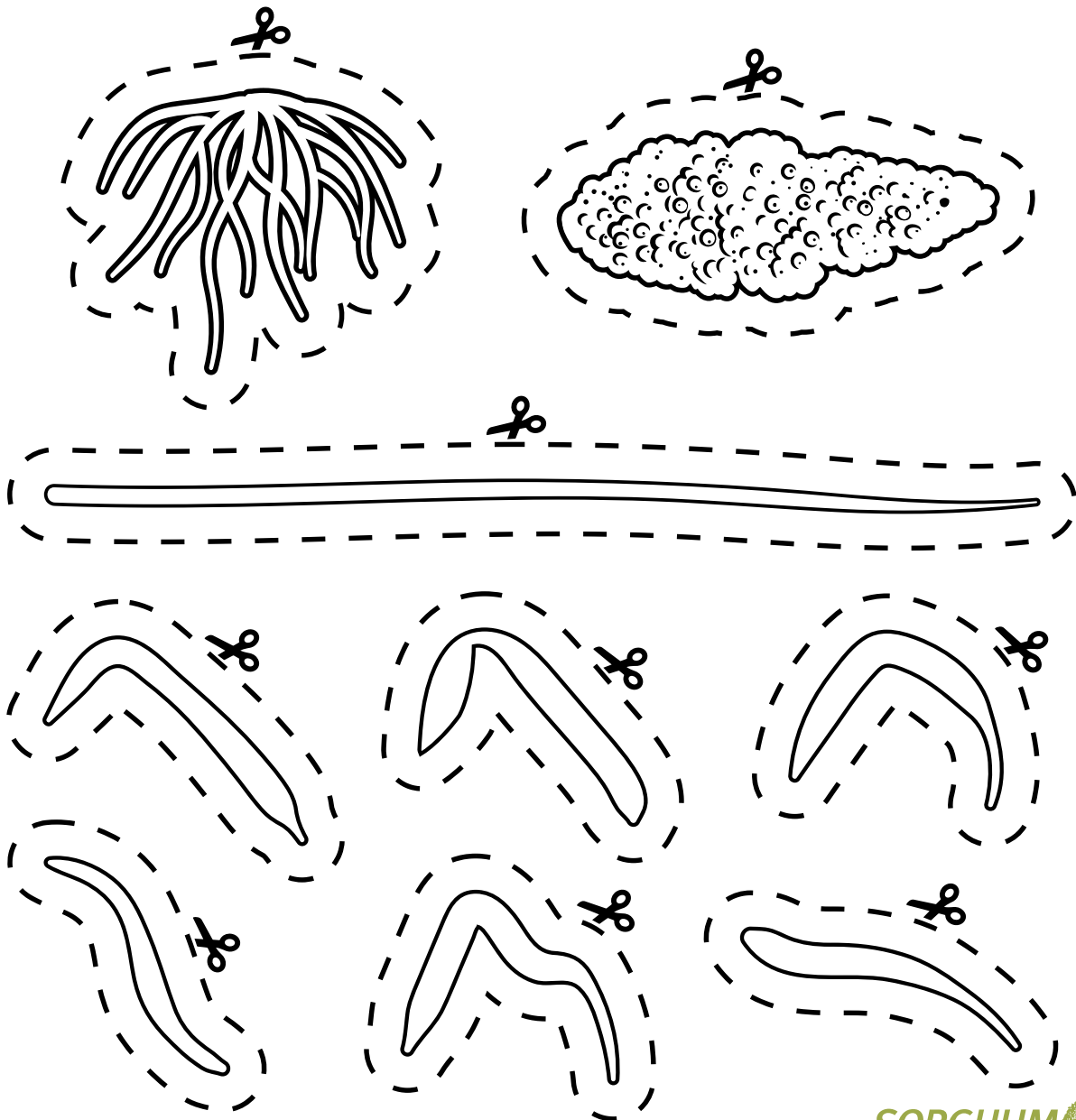


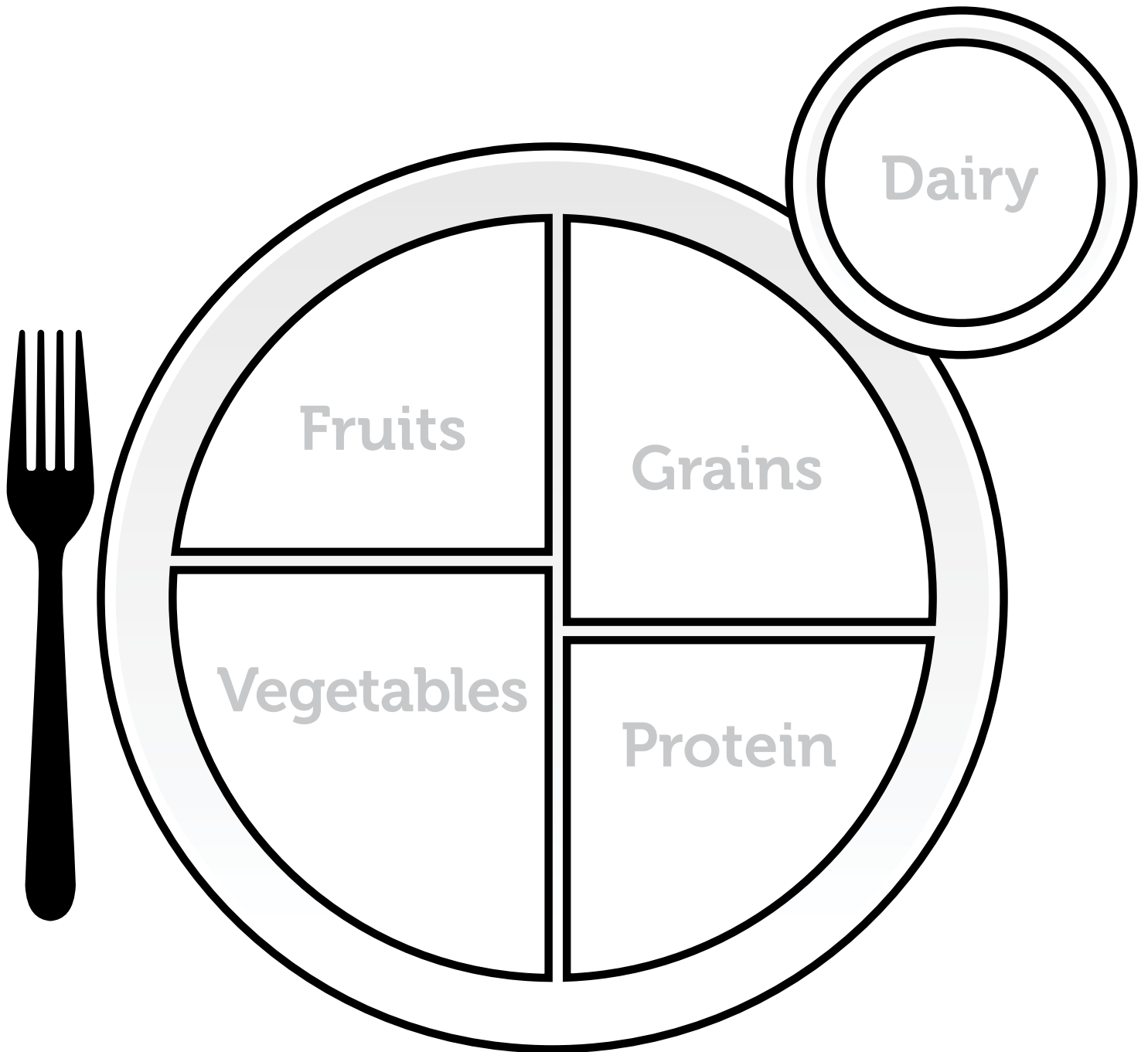


Learning About **SORGHUM**

1. Color, cut, and paste the shapes onto construction paper to make a sorghum plant. Use the Super Star Sorghum! Poster as a guide.



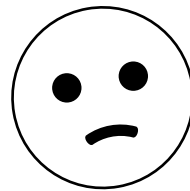
2. Where does sorghum fit on the MyPlate food guide?
