
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
# Historical U.S. tariffs



Japan, September 4<sup>th</sup>


- *Corn and Bioethanol mentioned as part of \$8 billion purchasing commitment by government of Japan*

United Kingdom, June 16<sup>th</sup>

- *Corn and beef purchases*

*Remaining: EU, South Korea, Vietnam, Indonesia, Philippines, Pakistan*

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# Ongoing Negotiations

## Mexico & Canada

- Still negotiating on reciprocal tariffs
- Canada recently lifted retaliatory tariffs as a gesture of good will
- USMCA six year review July 2026

## India

- Deal remains elusive
- India has tough negotiators, but we're making progress

## China

- Deal remains elusive
- New delay until Nov. 10th
- Current détente tariff rates of: 30% on Chinese imports to the U.S.  
10% on U.S imports to China



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# Summary

- Even if Trump loses at SCOTUS, tariffs will stay in some form
- Some in Congress complain, but most look the other way
- Tariffs are now foreign policy:
  - Brazil court case
  - 50% tariffs on India for buying Russian oil
  - Fentanyl & Border Security
- Post-WWII world order is being reshaped before our eyes
- Average U.S. Tariff Rate is now estimated at 18.6% up from an estimated 2.5% prior to Trump's first term.
